GET RID OF YOUR CHAMETZ!

Before Passover, it is mandated for Jewish homes to be cleansed of all Chametz. According to Jewish Law, the Chametz may be stored in a safe place in the home, and a “proxy” may be assigned to the Rabbi giving him authority to sell it to a non-Jew for the duration of the holiday. This year, Rabbi Joshua Kullock will be selling Chametz to Chief Anderson of the Metro Nashville Police. To assign power of attorney to Rabbi Joshua Kullock for the sale, log onto www.westendsyn.org, print the form and send it to the Rabbi *by Wednesday, March 28*.

It is customary to make a donation when ridding your house of Chametz. All donations should be made out to Rabbi’s Discretionary Fund which will be forwarded to one of two causes. The money provides for needy Jews who cannot afford to observe Passover in Nashville and will benefit Chief Anderson’s fund for families of fallen officers.
