Judy Kloss, Senior Lecturer of Jewish Studies and English at Vanderbilt, will teach on May 19 at 7:30 p.m. She'll teach about "Jews and American Popular Music." For much of the Twentieth Century, Jewish Americans wrote the majority of America's popular songs. They were the songwriters of Tin Pan Alley, and they were the ones, for the most part, who invented the Broadway musical. This talk will consider songwriting pioneers. It will touch on the problematic history of Jews and African-Americans in American music.

The evening will begin with Judy's lecture at 7:30 p.m. followed by Ma'ariv at 8:30 p.m., a dessert reception at 8:45 p.m., and then a class taught by Rabbi Joshua Kullock at 9:00 p.m.
