The B'nai Tzedek program establishes a Foundation account in the name of a Bar or Bat Mitzvah and has proven to be attractive to teens, who are learning the value of Tikkun Olam, the repair of the world.

Here's how it works: the member contributes a minimum of \$125, which is matched by \$250 from the Feldman–Hassenfeld Fund for B'nai Tzedek and \$125 from the Jewish Foundation. The teen then starts with a fund in the amount of at least \$500 and a new philanthropist is born! Members meet every year around Purim to make their annual recommendations to various charitable organizations.
